



## How to: Use Secure Text

Your medical provider uses Updox Secure Text to communicate with patients. Secure Text is a safe and easy way to send documents and messages, ensuring that all communication is private and complies with government security measures.

Follow these step-by-step instructions to use Secure Text:

	<p>You will receive a message with a link in it through your normal texting application.</p>
	<p>Clicking the link will take you to a page where you will enter your date of birth and your last name. This information allows us to set up a secure link between you and your provider.</p> <p>Next, you will be asked to set up a 5-digit PIN that you will use for future session. If you forget your PIN, just click "Forgot PIN", and you can easily set up a new one.</p>
	<p>You will then be entered into the Secure Text session. This will look and behave very much like other texting apps.</p> <p>Use the paperclip to add files or photos from your phone. Click "Enter message" to type. Click the arrow icon to send.</p>
